Current Requirements

***“Education,

- 17 Years of age or older
- Active member in good standing with the Alabama National Guard
- Active member of a federally recognized unit of the Alabama National Guard
- Have completed basic training
- Pursuing the first undergraduate or post graduate degree program
- Can only receive assistance with one degree





Current Requirements

***“Education,
The
KEY
to
Strength

Readiness”***

- Enrolled in a certificate or degree program at an accredited community or technical within the state of Alabama
- Maintain a cumulative 2.00 GPA for Undergraduate; 3.00 GPA for Graduate at the end of each semester
- Must have a FASFA on file
- Must demonstrate financial need of at least \$100.00
- Assistance will cover no more than a total of 120 academic hours

- Current award amounts
 - Semester - \$5,687.00
 - Quarter - \$3,791.33
- Change in residency Requirement
 - Can live in surrounding states, but **MUST**
 - Be a member of the Alabama National Guard- Air or Army
 - Be in good standing with the Alabama National Guard
 - Attend an accredited community college or technical college within the State of Alabama and enrolled in a degree program

- Any applications received after these dates by ACHE will not be paid.
 - ACHE can no longer accept late requests for payment
- Current deadlines are:
 - Fall 2022- October 28th / Paid December 2nd
 - Spring 2023- March 1st / Paid April 28th
 - Summer 2023 – June 30th / Paid July 28th (based on available funds)
 - At the end of Spring 2023 ACHE will ascertain if there are sufficient funds to cover the costs of Summer applications.

- If there is a projected shortfall, each institution will receive a percentage amount of the fund based on their percentage of the Summer 2023 or the actual amount due; whichever is less
 - be based on the previous year (Summer 20223 awards:
Fund Balance x institutional % of Summer FY 23 amount received.
- Institutions will be notified by March 8, 2023. If proration have to be declared, there will be ample time to notify the Soldiers prior to enrolling in Summer 2023 courses.
