The student is granted any waiver or forgiveness of tuition, fees, or other charges, where the institutional policy
for determining the recipient of such aid is not equal with respect to Veterans and nonveterans alike (i.e., restricted aid), excluding graduate students; OR

The student receives an institutionally funded loan, scholarship, or grant, where the institutional policy for determining the recipient of such aid is not equal with respect to Veterans and nonveterans alike (i.e., restricted aid), excluding graduate students; **OR**

The student is on a tuition and fee payment plan that does not meet all the stated requirements; **OR**

The student has not paid the full amount of tuition, fees, and other mandatory charges to the school prior to the reporting date (unless on a compliant tuition and fee payment plan for the balance).

COUNT THE STUDENT AS NON-SUPPORTED WHEN <u>ALL</u> OF THE FOLLOWING ARE TRUE

\bigcirc	The student is not using GI Bill benefits under Title 10 or Title 38 (chapters 30, 31, 33, 35, 1606, VET-TEC); AND
\bigcirc	If the student is granted any waiver or forgiveness of tuition, fees, or other charges, then the institutional policy for determining the recipient of such aid is equal with respect to Veterans and nonveterans alike, or is a graduate student; AND
\bigcirc	If the student receives an institutionally funded loan, scholarship, or grant, then the institutional policy for determining the recipient of such aid is equal with respect to Veterans and nonveterans alike, or is graduate student; AND
\bigcirc	If the student is on a tuition and fee payment plan, then the payment plan meets all the stated requirements; AND
\bigcirc	There are no outstanding tuition, fees, and other mandatory charges owed to the school as of the reporting date (unless the balance is covered by a compliant tuition and fee payment plan).

The availability and requirements of the payment plan are available for review and/or inspection by students, the State approving agency, and VA on the school's website; AND

- The availability and requirements of the payment plan are available for review and/or inspection by students, the State approving agency, and VA in a dated hard copy on file at every campus of the school; AND
- The payment plan is available to any enrolled student who is interested in participating; AND

The payment plan explicitly requires the student to pay the outstanding balance by the end of the 85/15 reporting period (academic term or calendar quarter) (i.e., the school requires the payment plan to be paid off in full no later than the end of the term); AND

The payment plan must be paid in full before students can begin training for the next term.
