AVAA developed this scholarship opportunity to provide additional funds in support of those individuals as they maneuver the financial challenges of education.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- A completed Alabama Veteran Affairs Association scholarship application.
- Unconditionally admitted to an Alabama college or university and in pursuit a certificate, undergraduate or graduate degree.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation from a school/college official (school certifying official, veteran administrator, counselor or instructor) or an employer.
- A 500-word essay explaining the need for a college education, your career goals and how you
 will use your prior experiences as a Veteran, Service Member or dependent of Veteran to give
 back to your community or organization.
- Must be U.S. citizen and resident of the State of Alabama.
- The School Certifying Official or Veteran Administrator at the institution you are or will attend will evaluate each application to ensure eligibility as a Veteran, Service Member, or Dependent based on the criteria of this scholarship and documentation of status as a Veteran, Service Member or dependent.
- The School Certifying Official or Veteran Administrator at the institution you are or will be
 attending will submit the completed application packet to the (Point of Contact) as appointed by
 the Board of Directors of the Alabama Veteran Affairs Association by the established deadline
 each conference year.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Alabama Veteran Affairs Association scholarship is designed to provide financial assistance with tuition, fees, books, or supplies and is provided to the institution on your behalf. All unused funds are refundable to the student when all financial obligations are met. The scholarship committee will evaluate each application for completeness, documents required to accompany the application, content of the essay and letters of recommendation.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. All scholarship recipients must maintain a minimum overall G.P.A. of 2.0/4.0 scale and be meeting satisfactory academic progress based on the institutional policy of the college or university of attendance for consideration.
- 2. Scholarship funds may be used in the current semester or the concurrent semester of attendance. Scholarship funds must be utilized in the current academic year of awarding.
- 3. At notification of awarding, each recipient must submit a photo/headshot along with a brief summary to include:
 - o Institution of attendance
 - Program of pursuit
 - Any information that can be presented about yourself to the entire membership at the annual conference and on the AVAA website at the annual conference.
