 Financial assistance to help Soldiers with off-duty voluntary civilian educational pursuits

How Do I Qualify?

- Actively serving in the ARNG
- Successfully complete AIT, WOBC, or BOLC.
- Not flagged or pending unfavorable action
- Maintain 2.0 undergraduate or 3.0 for graduate GPA*

**Important!* Soldiers in undergraduate classes receiving F or D grades and Soldiers in graduate classes receiving C, D, or F grades will be recouped any FTA funds paid.

- If you used FTA for a bachelor's degree, you must complete Advance Leaders Course, Captain Career Course, Warrant Officer Advanced Course or equivalent prior to using FTA for a master's degree.
- Commit to service obligation:
 - Commissioned Officers/Warrants CW2, 2LT and above (2 years/AGR, 4 years/TPU/Mday)
 - Enlisted/Warrants One (complete FTA-funded courses prior to ETS)

Important! *FTA will not pay for a <u>second</u> degree at any level (except certificates), regardless of the funding used for the first degree.

*FTA does not cover fees or books.

- 100% of tuition cost up to \$250 per semester hour
- Up to 16 semester hours per fiscal year (1 OCT 30 SEP)
- May be used towards an Undergraduate or Graduate Certificate, Associate, Bachelor's, or Master's degree*
- Career limits for FTA are:
 - 130 undergraduate semester hours
 - 39 graduate semester hours
 - 21 semester hours for undergraduate/graduate certificate (every five years)
- May be used with Chapter 1606 GI Bill benefits

- Create an ArmylgnitED account
 - Go to <u>www.armyignited.com</u> and establish an account by clicking on the "Get Started" option.
- All Federal TA requests must be submitted and approved <u>prior</u> to the course start date.
 - Soldiers may apply up to 60 days prior of course start date.
 - You must submit an FTA request for each individual course for funding.
- For assistance:
 - Contact an Army Education Counselor or Create a ServiceNow (SNOW) Help Desk case.

- Provides financial assistance to help pay for a credential or licensure listed on the Army COOL Web site
- How Do I Qualify?
 - Soldiers may begin work on their first credential upon successful completion of AIT, WOBC or BOLC

Soldier cannot be flagged

- Soldier's ArmylgnitED account cannot be on hold (Acceptable holds: Tier, GPA, Civ. Ed, Student Agreement)
- Soldier must complete the course before they are separated or ETS





What Do I Get?

- CA will provide Soldiers up to \$4,000 each year to pay for an eligible credential.
- Soldiers may use both FTA and CA; however, the combined usage shall not exceed \$4,000 per FY.
- **Credentials must be listed on the Army COOL web site at:** https://www.cool.osd.mil/army/ but does not have to be related to the Soldier's MOS.
- CA will pay expenses for classroom, hands-on, online/blended training and associated materials to include: manuals, study guides, textbooks, processing fees, test fees, related fees for continuing education requirements, and recertification of credentials.

- CA pays training, materials, books, tests/exams, and fees
- Everything is paid <u>PRIOR</u> to the start date of the course/credential/exam and Soldiers will be notified by HQ ACCESS either by phone or email (this can be from an automated message).
- Most requests are processed no later than 3 days prior to the Soldier's selected start date. If Soldier has not received a response prior to that, submit a SNOW case to request status.
- Soldiers who pay out of pocket for anything will <u>NOT</u> be reimbursed
- Books and materials paid by HQ ACCESS Army University are mailed to the Soldier directly

- Ensure your credential is listed on Army COOL at: <u>https://www.cool.osd.mil/army/</u>
 - Ensure you have an active ArmylgnitED account
 - Ensure your training provider is on the approved list on Army COOL (if not, have them submit a request via the Army COOL web site)





ArmylgnitED TA Request Process Overview

To support a Soldier Student's education journey, ArmylgnitED and Education Institutions (EIs) will work to automate the listed data exchanges to improve the Student's user experience and reduce manual data entry, and in turn reduce data errors.



Definitions

Inbound: File sent from El to ArmylgnitED Outbound: File sent from ArmylgnitED to El

TA Request Timeline Policy Remains the Same

- Soldiers can request TA up to 60 days before the start date of a class
- TA must be requested and approved before the start date of a class
